Cowes Week

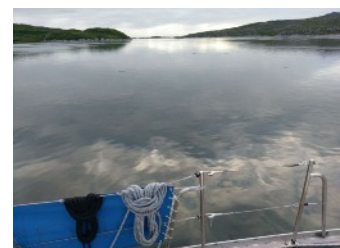
