Jack Trigger, professional solo sailor, type 1 diabetic, will be talking about his experiences in the world of single handed sailing.

At just 26 years old Jack has an impressive track record, including multiple world records, a Fastnet race win, and experience sailing anything from high speed MOD 70 trimarans to hydrofoiling IMOCA 60s. In 2018 he took part in the famous 'Route du Rhum' solo transatlantic race from St Malo, France to Guadeloupe. Crossing the finish line after 18 gruelling days he became not only the first type 1 diabetic to compete in a solo ocean race, but also the youngest competitor to complete the edition, finishing in 8th/53. He rounded out the season championship in 4th place.

With ambitions to join the list of elite yachtsmen and women who have competed in the Vendée Globe, Jack will talk about his adventures to date, future plans, and the challenges he faces whilst competing to the highest level and managing Type 1 Diabetes.
