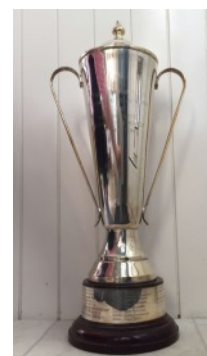
Evening at the club

## Membership Structure and Subscriptions 2019/20

As announced at the A.G.M. - from the start of the new membership year, (1st April 2019), there will be changes to our membership structure and subscriptions.

There will no longer be categories of Full or Social Membership. The categories will be amalgamated into Ordinary Membership, with a single or family option.

The subscriptions for Ordinary Membership will be as follows:

Full year Ordinary Single Membership £185 or direct debit monthly of £17 - available to adults over 26 years.

Full year Ordinary Family Membership £285 or direct debit monthly of £26 - includes two adults at the same address and children under 18 .

Concessionary membership £99 - applies to adults aged 18-26, full-time students, long term unemployed or those with disabilities (supporting documentation required). This is unchanged.

All Ordinary Members will benefit from the same terms in the Club: for instance a full vote at general meetings and 20% discount on food and drink.

New members will be asked to pay a one-off joining fee of £25 each. This will also apply to members who have allowed their membership to lapse for longer than one month.

The subscription increases are justified by the need to keep the Club operating and well-maintained as members would expect.
