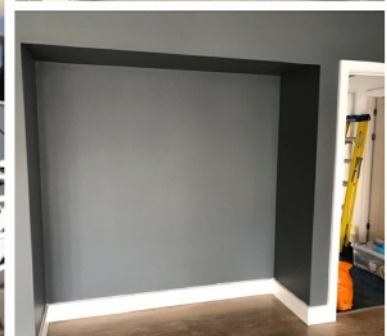
The decorating at the club is progressing beautifully..... can't wait until you can all see it properly!
