Frostbite Series 2022

This Notice of Race serves as an invitation to compete in the Frostbite Series 2022 and to provide guidance on how the races will operate.

FORMAT

- a) **Online entry/payment:** (pre-booking) is essential; there is no facility to enter via sign-on at the clubhouse on the day. Please ensure your booking(s) align to the day(s) you will compete, this helps our administration.
- b) **Communication:**
 - i) Pre and Post Race: via email (racing@bmyc.uk) or via the BMYC Race Management WhatsApp Group.
 - ii) On the Day of Race: the BMYC Race Management WhatsApp Group or via Marine Band VHF Radio on Ch77.
*n.b. Sign-On on the day from 90min before the race start, to confirm you will compete – see schedule overleaf.
Reserved Format: [Boat Name – Sign-On].*
- c) **Declaration:** All participating boats MUST declare ASAP after sailing; I.E. before packing the boat away. Reserved Format: [Boat Name – Declared].

COVID-SAFE POLICY

Time-Out

Combined Group: 90 minutes after the first boat has finished.

Declaration

Required, ALL Boats, via BMYC Race Management WhatsApp Group - ASAP after sailing; I.E. before packing the boat away. Reserved Format: [Boat Name – Declared].
 n.b. Not Declared Correctly Scored DND (=DNF)

Scoring

Low Point – RRS Appendix A	4-5 Races Completed – 1 Discard Allowed
6 Races Completed – 2 Discards Allowed	3 Races or less – All to count
